Historical May Moments

- ◆ May 1, 1931 - The Empire State Building in New York City was dedicated.
- ◆ May 3, 1851 - A catastrophic fire broke out which destroyed as much as three-quarters of San Francisco, California.
- ◆ May 4, 1886 - The Haymarket Riot, a violent confrontation between police and labor protesters, in Chicago. The event became a symbol of the international struggle for workers' rights.
- ◆ May 5, 1893 - New York Stock Exchange crashes triggered by the so-called "Panic of 1893".
- ◆ May 9, 1865 - The American Civil War officially ended.
- ◆ May 10, 1869 - The Transcontinental Railroad was completed.
- ◆ May 10, 1969 - The Lake Pontchartrain Causeway northbound bridge in southeastern Louisiana, United States was opened.
- ◆ May 14, 1804 - Lewis and Clark Expedition set out to cross the newly acquired western portion of the United States after the Louisiana Purchase.
- ◆ May 14, 1904 - The first Olympic games held on US soil was opened in St. Louis, Missouri.
- ◆ May 27, 1937 - The Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco was opened after 4 years of construction.
- ◆ May 30, 1854 - The Kansas-Nebraska Act become effective. This law was enacted to organize the territories of Nebraska and Kansas and thereby repealed the Missouri Compromise which then stoked national tensions over slavery.
